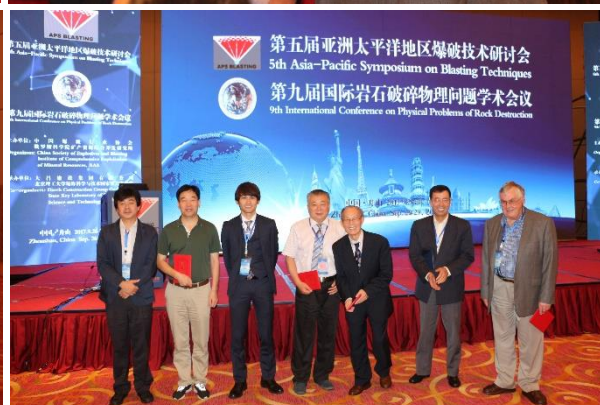
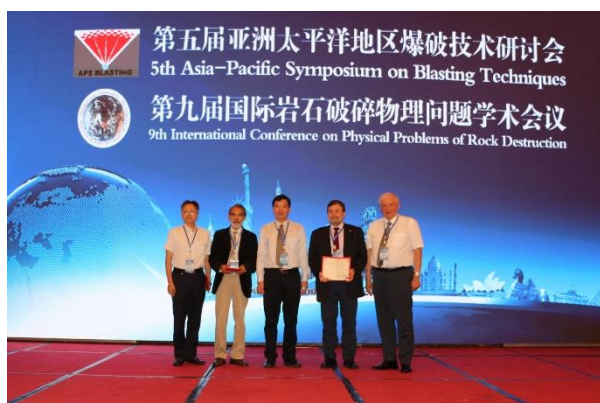

The Asia-Pacific Symposium on Blasting Techniques (**APS BLASTING**) is the symposium for scientific and technical update on all aspects of explosives and blasting in Asia and the Pacific. It was initiated by China Society of Explosives and Blasting (**CSEB**) and is held every two to three years. Since it was first held in Kunming, China in 2007, it has been held five times. APS BLASTING 2 to 5 were held together with the International Conference on Physical Problems of Rock Destruction.

With the general consensus of the organizing committees, the 6th edition (**APS BLASTING 6**) will be held in **Chongqing, China in July, 2025**.

APS BLASTING 6 is intended to provide an opportunity for experts, scholars, as well as entrepreneurs throughout the Asia-Pacific area to exchange their academic and technical achievements in engineering blasting, explosives industry and other related fields. The purposes of the Symposium are to respond to the needs of civil engineering and construction community, to work out effective countermeasures for the opportunities and challenges faced by engineering blasting, and to make greater contribution to further development of blasting technology.

Experts, professors, and engineers involved in explosives industry, engineering blasting, geology, mining and other related fields are warmly welcome to the Symposium.

TOPICS

The main topics include but not limited to the followings:

- **Theoretical research on explosion and blasting**
- **Engineering blasting technology, especially precision blasting and intelligent blasting**
- **Blasting materials and initiation technology**
- **Blasting machines, tools, instrument and apparatus**
- **Blast safety management, etc.**

Abstracts must be submitted to apsblasting@163.com by **September 30, 2024**.

In 200-400 words, your abstract should summarize the major points of your proposed 5-10 page paper.

3 to 5 keywords are required. Title of the paper, together with names, affiliation, and email address of the author(s), should be attached.

Papers must be submitted and presented in English, the official language of the conference.

CITY

Chongqing is one of four direct-controlled municipalities in China (the others are Beijing, Shanghai, and Tianjin), located in central China, intersected by the Jialing River as well as the Yangtze River.



Chongqing is renowned in China for being a "mountain city". It is constructed on the tall peaks, low valleys and sloping hills of the mountainside. When strolling about the downtown area, you will find yourself walking uphill and downhill along the undulating streets, and may be surprised by seeing a light rail rushing through a residential building. The brilliant nightscape of the town is equally famous. Around the Chongqing urban area, there are some scenic and historical highlights such as Dazu County with ancient rock carvings and art, the rocky scenery at Wulong, the Zigong Dinosaur Museum, the Yangtze River and the 3 Gorges Dam.
